

You may want to talk about: why you like it, how it is made, what you can see, where the person is looking, and why, what it represents, explain composition, theme of the painting, light, use of colour, contrast, how edges are defined, style of painting/ drawing/ photograph/ collage, and how it makes you feel. • Compare them, finding things/aspects that are similar. • Contrast them, finding things/aspects that are different. • If you still have time, create a sketch of how you would do a portrait, add notes explaining how, what and why. <p>Write your name surname, class code and present the work to your teacher when you are back in your class.</p> 	<p>If you finish the work in less than 1 hour and 15 minutes create your own design where you can practice blending colour.
