




Copy the definitions in a page</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Tone</u> - The lights the darks and everything in between. We use different tones when we use shading to create form (shape) in an image. • <u>Directional shading</u>- Shading in different directions to emphasise the features of something. <p>TASK: Shade the line image to look like the photo, use tone from white to black and directional shading.</p> <p>If in the study room, ask for an Art sheet to use for this task.
