

Homework

- In the first term, students will be set HW from Maths and English only.
- Both subjects use a platform called Sparx (Maths and Reader).
- Students will be shown how to access and use these platforms.
- More information will be available in September.

 Other subjects may set optional HW as an enrichment opportunity. These tasks are not compulsory but give students an opportunity to go above and beyond the bare minimum and to be rewarded for doing so.





Academic Grouping

- In September, students will be grouped based on their KS2 data.
- Students in year 7, 8 and 9 are streamed for Maths, English and Science.
- This means they are in the same class for all three subjects.
- Streams are calculated using an average of a student's ranks in Maths, English and Science:

Student A	Maths Rank	English Rank	Science Rank	Average Rank	Stream
	35	14	26	24.6	1

In the example above the student has an average rank of 24.6 placing them in stream 1. Their Maths rank alone would place them in stream 2 however we recognise their ability in the other core subjects and so they enter the higher stream.


